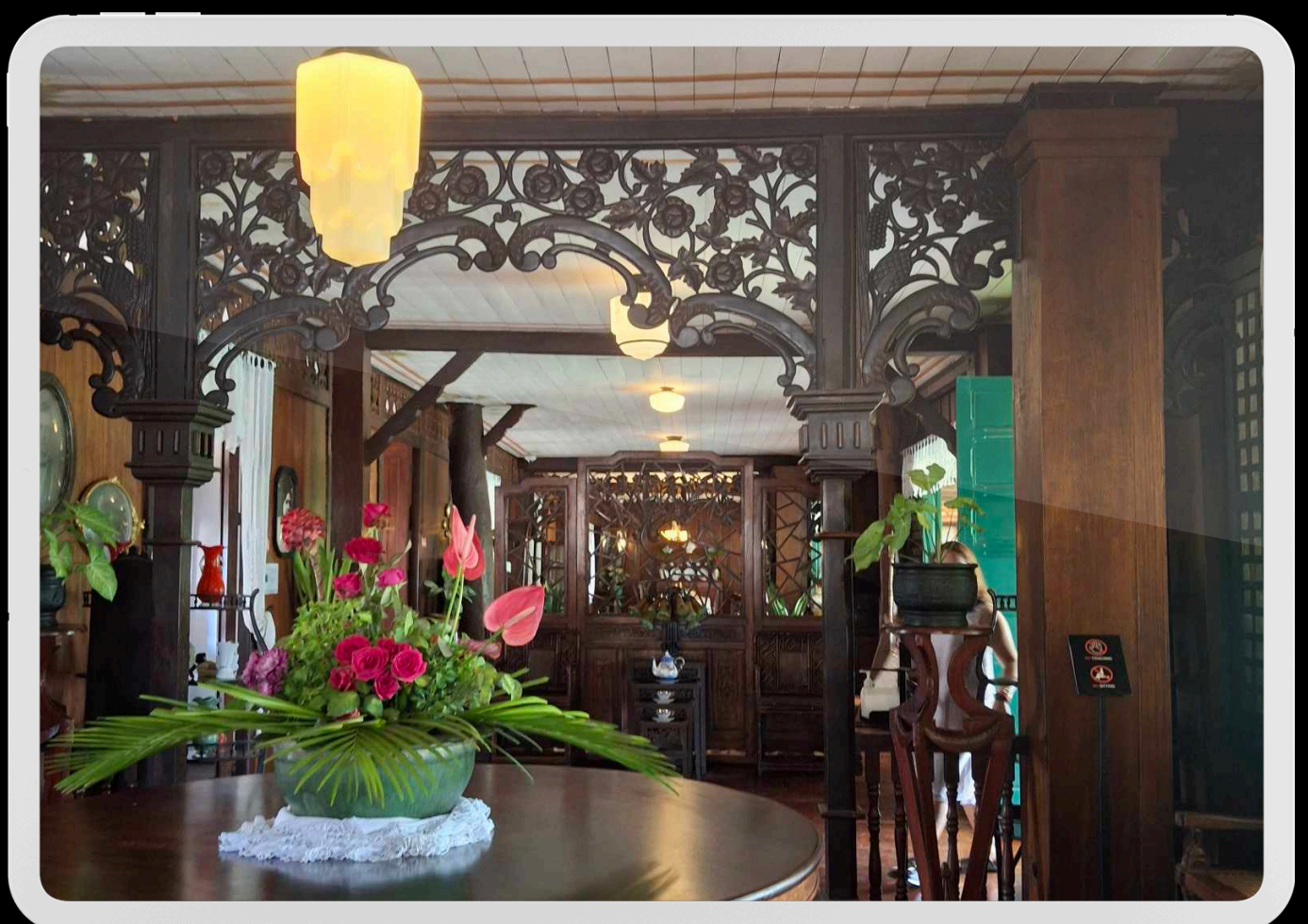




On the second day, librarians and staff gathered for the fellowship night.
